

MBC MASTER THESIS GUIDELINES

It is recommended to decide on the type of word processing software (*e.g.* OpenOffice, LibreOffice, Microsoft Word) to use for the drafting of the thesis in agreement with your supervisor. The thesis must be in English.

RECOMMENDED TEXT FORMATTING SETTINGS

- Top, bottom and right margins of the page: 3 cm
- Left margin of the page: 3,5 cm
- Line spacing: 1,5
- Main text font and size: either Serif or Sans Serif fonts among the most commonly used ones (*e.g.* Times New Roman, Arial, Calibri, Cambria); 12 pt. The selected font should be used for the entire main text.
- Figure captions font and size: either Serif or Sans Serif fonts among the most commonly used ones; 9-10 pt. It may differ from that used for the main text, as long as it is kept for all captions.
- The main text should be justified
- Titles of chapters, paragraphs, subparagraphs, *etc.* should be in bold.
- Pages should be numbered

CHAPTERS

The thesis work should be divided into:

- **Index:** List of titles of chapter, paragraph and subparagraph. It should provide the page numbering.
- **Abstract:** Summary of the work (1-2 pages). It should provide in a few phrases an overview of the scientific background, the aims of the work and the main results. It must be included both in English and Italian.
- **Introduction:** This chapter contains all the scientific background required to understand the thesis work.
- **Materials and Methods:** In this chapter, all the protocols employed during the thesis stages should be described in detail following the recommendations from the Biomolecular methods laboratory course.
- **Results:** Here should be described the experimental design and the obtained results. Supportive figures should be included.
- **Conclusions:** In this chapter, the obtained results should be critically discussed in light of what is known from the literature.
- **Bibliography:** List of the cited papers along the entire thesis work.
